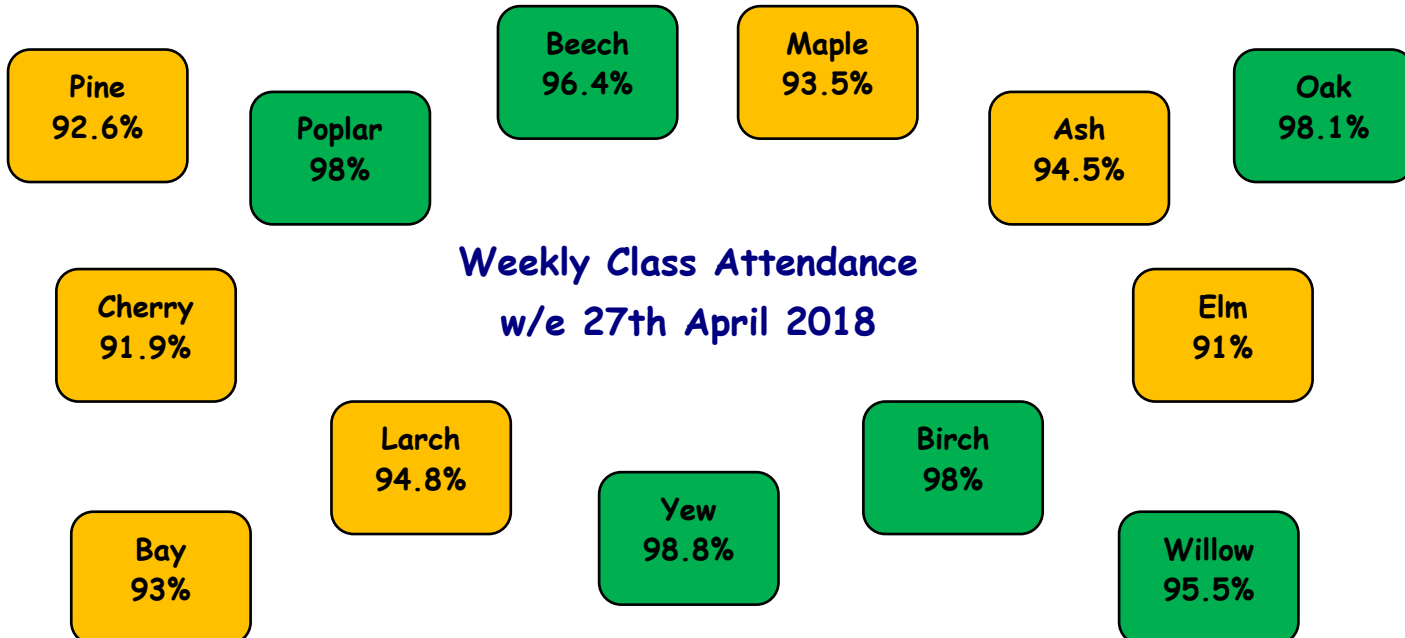

Summer Uniform Policy

We would like to remind all parents of our summer uniform policy.

Girls:

Black or grey trousers, skirt or pinafore with a white blouse. In summer girls may wear blue checked or striped dresses. Royal blue cardigan or jumper.

Boys:

Black or grey trousers or shorts, shirt or polo shirt. Royal blue cardigan or jumper.

Please ensure your child wears sensible black shoes - no colourful trainers, platforms or flimsy sandals please. All shoes **must** have a back on them.

PE Kit is a plain white T-shirt and black shorts.

Also, please avoid sending your child to school in jewellery that can either be lost or damaged.

Stud earrings may be worn but must be removed for PE.

Please ensure that all clothes and shoes belonging to your child are clearly named.
