

Unexplained Absences Procedure including Pupil Sickness

I am writing to remind you of our school procedure for children who have unexplained absences from school.

There have been public cases in the past where schools have not chased up the reasons as to why children are out of school. It has then transpired that there have been tragic circumstances around these absences, e.g. illness of a parent and a child unable to seek help.

We will do everything we can to prevent such situations occurring as I am sure you would agree that your child's safety is paramount to us all.

If your child is not going to be in school please call the office on 01724 842608 or email the school on info@wrpacademy.org.uk to report their absence. Please do this before 8.30am on the first day of the absence.

If we have not heard from you by 9.15am then we will start to call all the contact numbers that you have provided in order to gain an explanation for the absence. If we still have not been able to ascertain where your child is then we will make a home visit. **However** if we still haven't been able to get a response then we will report it to the police as your child will then be classed a 'missing child'.

This procedure is to ensure that we know where your child is and that you are all safe. Please always let us know in good time why your child is absent from school.

It is important that we have an up to date list of contact numbers (up to four).
